## **Issues and Campaigns Committee Resolutions**

### **Short-Term Issue**

**Application Process:** The following items need to be submitted by the Chapter for the Issues Committee to review the issue

- o An Issue Title
- o 5 Sub-questions directly relating to the Issue
- o 5 online sources (e.g. News Articles, Journal Articles, etc.) on Issue, with no more than 2 coming from the same source
- o 500 word statement analyzing and explaining why the membership should discuss this issue.

These will be issues to be discussed by the membership online for the duration of a month. The applications need to be in by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the previous month. Every 1<sup>st</sup> of the month there will be a new pressing issue posted.

### **Long-Term Issue**

The Issue selected to be deliberated as the Quarterly Issue must be the Issue which most members have identified as the most important global issue.

A minimum of 10% of the membership of each country must participate in the global issue identification in order for that country's members' issues to be considered.

The issues deliberated at the Annual SWA Convention and presented on by experts will be the 3 quarterly issues previously discussed by the membership

- The Issues discussed (quarterly and pressing) must only come either from individual students or student chapters, these will be approved by the Issues Committee  
Amendment: No SWA Chapter is allowed to endorse any entity in pursuing any issues.

Any type of collaborated discussion or debate between SWA and other entities must be approved by the Issues Committee
